


Microneedling: What is it?


Microneedling is a minimally invasive technique that creates thousands of epidermal microchannels that allow substances to pass through the horny layer of the skin, maximising the activity of the active substances.



Many micropunctures are made, which in turn generate thousands of microchannels.



This facilitates the penetration of active substances that are applied topically at the same time as microchannel creation



The active substances reach the deepest skin layers, maximising their effect.

Effects

- Activates the skin repair mechanisms
- Neduces the appearance of expression lines and pore size
- 03 Reduces the appearance of hypertrophic scars and stretch marks
- 04 Improves skin firmness
- 05 Stimulates the hair follicles



Indications

- Scalp hair loss
- Hands, face and décolletage lack of vitality
- · Face, décolletage, hands and other body zones hyperpigmentation
- Neck, face and double chin flaccidity and wrinkles
- Inner surfaces of the arms, legs, abdomen and flanks localised fat
- · Knees (inner surfaces) and legs cellulite

Post treatment home care

There will be a short period of downtime after your treatment including moderate erythema (very pink/red skin) immediately afterwards, this is completely normal. The redness will take anywhere between 24 - 72 hours to completely go away and will feel like a mild sunburn. In most cases the pinkness to the skin usually resolves within 24 - 48 hours.

Make-up can be applied 24 hours after treatment. Please do not use any active serums or treatment steps within the recovery phase.

The below home care products are recommended to be used post treatment:

Hygiene

hydra milk cleanser 200ml

Effectively removes make-up and impurities, provides intense hydration and respects the skin's physiological balance. Its soothing properties provide a pleasant feeling of comfort.

Usage: Apply in the morning and at night with fingertips over the face, neck and décolletage with a circular motion. Remove the product with sponges or wet cotton pads.



Hygiene

hydratonic 200ml

Facial tonic lotion with an astringent effect for all types of skin. It removes residual impurities and decongests the skin, leaving it fresh, soft and smooth. The absence of alcohol in its composition respects skin pH and prevents dehydration.



Usage: After the cleansing stage, wet a cotton pads and apply over the face, neck and décolletage.

Skin care

post-procedure fast skin repair 50ml

A calming and soothing cream with a complex formulation to enhance wound healing.

Usage: Apply over the treated area with a gentle massage until complete absorption each time you experience tight skin.



Moisturiser

hydrating moisturiser with sun protection 50ml

Helps to prevent skin ageing and the occurrence of hyperpigmentation, with moisturising and antioxidant properties. It is the essential complement to skin needling treatments, as well as for continuous maintenance.



Usage: Apply daily after treatment and/or after cleansing and toning. Repeat as necessary.

The skin will recover quickly if the above home care products are used. Once the skin is no longer sensitive, you can return to your normal skin care routine. A period of 3 - 5 days is recommended before reverting to your normal routine.

Please also note that the skin can go through a 'slight flaking' stage 1 - 2 days post needling. This is perfectly normal and is due to the needles interruption of the epidermis. The skin will return to normal within 24 - 72 hours.
